

As part of Indian Trail Improvement District's efforts to continue engaging the Public and taking steps to prevent potential spread of COVID-19, Indian Trail Improvement District is hosting an online Board of Supervisors Workshop Meeting on June 3, 2020, commencing at 6:00 P.M.

The purpose of this Online Workshop Meeting includes online public participation in conjunction with Indian Trail's Public Facilities Report by developing an overall District Transportation System based on "Complete Streets Mobility Concepts" and to receive comments from residents relating to the Planning for Mobility (Vehicle, Horse, Bicycle & Pedestrian) affecting residents and to discuss the District's resources, roadway and sidewalk system, and to initiate involvement from residents.

Following the direction of Governor Ron DeSantis and the Florida Department of Health to avoid large in-person gatherings and promote social distancing during the COVID-19 Emergency, this Workshop Meeting will be held and may be attended by the Public only using ZOOM, a Communications Media Technology (CMT). ZOOM is a free online meeting tool that can be accessed from any computer, tablet, or smart phone. Any evidence, testimony, and argument which is offered utilizing CMT shall be afforded equal consideration as if it were offered in person, and shall be subject to the same objections.
